

BY-LAW NO. 14 (A)

A BY-LAW TO AMEND BY-LAW NO. 14, BUILDING BY-LAW FOR THE VILLAGE OF GAGETOWN

Under the authority vested in it by section 74 of the *Community Planning Act*, the Council of the Village of Gagetown, duly convened, enacts this by-law as an amendment to By-law No. 14, Building By-law, by repealing section 11. of the said by-law and replacing it with the following:

11. (1) The fee for a building permit for a building or structure to which the National Building Code applies is \$25.00 plus \$2.50 for each \$1,000.00 of the estimated construction cost of the building or structure.
- (2) The fee for a building permit for a building or structure, which is exempted from the application of the National Building Code, is \$25.00.
- (3) Where the building inspector is of the opinion that the estimated cost of construction of the building or structure provided by an applicant is unreasonable, the building inspector may refuse to issue the building permit.
- (4) All applications for a building permit shall be accompanied by a minimum payment of \$25.00, the balance to be paid prior to the permit being issued.


