WINTER PARKING

INTERPRETATION

1. In in this by-law, unless the context otherwise requires,
 - (a) words which are defined in Section 1 of the Motor Vehicles Act 1955 have the meaning as so defined for the purposes of this by-law.

RESTRICTED PARKING

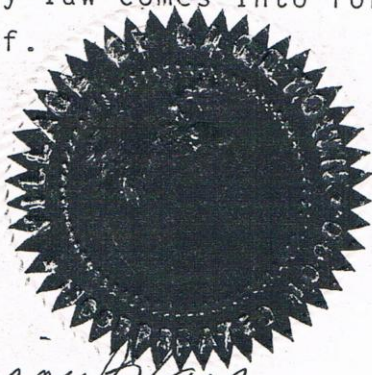
2. In the months of December, January, February and March, between the hours of midnight and seven o'clock in the forenoon of any day, no person shall park a vehicle unattended on any highway or street within the Village of Gagetown limits.

IMPOUNDING OF VEHICLES

3. A peace officer may remove and impound any vehicle which is found illegally parked on any highway or street, and no person shall take possession of a vehicle so removed or impounded until all costs and charges for; removal, care and storage of such vehicle have been paid.

PENALTIES

4. Any person who violates any provision of this by-law is guilty of an offence and is liable on summary conviction to a fine of not less than ten dollars and not more than fifty dollars.
5. This by-law comes into force on the date of final passing thereof.
